# MUNSTER MID-AMATEUR OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP

## LIMERICK GOLF CLUB 4<sup>TH</sup> & 5<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER 2010

### CONDITIONS

1. The Championship Committee, which shall consist of Officials appointed by the Munster Provincial Council of the Golfing Union of Ireland and Officials appointed by Limerick Golf Club, shall be responsible for the organisation and management of the Championship and its decision shall be final on all matters relating thereto including acceptance of entries.
2. (a) The Championship will be decided over 54 holes medal play, over 2 days, 36 holes being played on the first day. After 36 holes, the leading 45 competitors and all those tying for 45th place, shall play a further 18 holes on the second day.  
(b) **Qualification**
  - (i) Thirty-five years or over on 1<sup>st</sup> day of the Championship.
  - (ii) Entries will be limited to the 99 lowest handicapped players at closing date for receipt of entries.
  - (iii) A standby list of the next lowest 15 players will be used in the event of withdrawals.
  - (c) Method for the breaking of ties for 54 holes – decide on last 36, last 18. If still a tie – decide as for 18 holes. In the event of a tie for first place, the Championship will be decided by a play-off.
  - (d) To be eligible a competitor must have submitted a MINIMUM of 4 returns to his Home Club during the previous calendar year prior to the closing date of the Championship.
3. The Championship shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R & A and in accordance with the Local Rules of the Housing club, as approved by the Championship Committee.
4. A general pace of play condition will be implemented whereby 60 seconds will be the time allotted for addressing and hitting the ball once it is the players turn to play. Following 2 warnings of breach, the penalty will be 2 shots.
5. Official practice day is the day prior to the commencement of the Championship at the discretionary times as arranged with the Secretary/Manager of the Housing Club.
6. If a competitor fails to show at the tee without notification, entry may be refused the following year at the discretion of the Championship Committee.

**N.B. These rules must be read in conjunction with the General Rules for Union Championships.**
